The walk's philanthropic partner is PAWS Chicago, the city's largest No Kill animal shelter, which will receive one hundred percent of auction proceeds.

One hundred percent of auction proceeds benefit PAWS Chicago, which will have animals available for adoption at all our showroom locations, though the event is not open to guest pets. Each showroom will have light bites and cocktails. The walk is \$35 and is open to the public. Tickets must be purchased in advance. Check-in at one of our eleven locations and receive a wristband for full access. Guests can catch our trolley provided by Terrazzo & Marble Supply Companies from the south end of the River North Design District to the north.

PAWS Chicago is one of the largest comprehensive No Kill animal welfare organizations in the nation, building programs to end the killing of homeless pets. PAWS is best known for healing and rehabilitating around 5,000 homeless cats and dogs each year at its state-of-the-art homeless pet hospital and finding them loving families through its adoption program. PAWS Chicago also operates the city's largest high-volume spay/neuter clinic, providing more than 16,000 low- or no-cost spay/neuter surgeries each year and low-cost and free medical care for owned pets in need. Since its founding in 1997, when more than 42,000 pets were killed in Chicago, PAWS Chicago has led the reduction in homeless pet euthanasia in Chicago by 90.2 percent.
